# Past Meetings

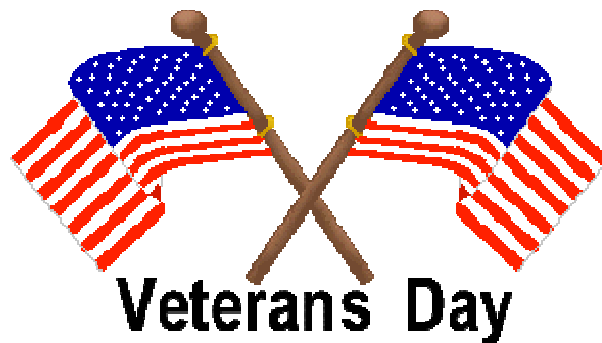
